Group story – <i>Inch by Inch</i> by Leo Lionni																	
Group story – <i>The Hungry Thing Returns</i> by Jan Slepian then do “Hungry Thing Snacks” activity																	
Group story – <i>Today is Monday</i> by Eric Carle																	
Group story – <i>In the Tall, Tall Grass</i> by Denise Fleming																	
Group story – <i>I am Eyes</i> by Leila Ward																	
Group story – <i>Miss Spider's ABC</i> by David Kirk																	
Group story – <i>The Lamb and the Butterfly</i> by Arnold Sundgaard																	
Sing song at circle – “A Caterpillar Song”																	
Sing song at circle – “Butterflies”																	
Circle – put larvae into butterfly garden and wait 21 days for them to hatch into butterflies																	
Circle – daily check on larvae, observe and note (kids can document and record changes) butterfly cycle																	
Circle – play “Grab Bag Surprise”																	
Circle – sort healthy foods from “junk foods”																	
Circle – describe and chart what we know about cocoons																	
Circle – write class poem “If I were a Butterfly”
